He also worked for a Congressman and later held high level positions within the Pentagon working for the Joint Chiefs of Staff. He was a Program Director within the U.S. Department of Justice and later selected as an Intelligence Officer for the Defense Intelligence Agency. He returned from Iraq in 2008 working with U.S. Special Forces.
